Theme: *Nourish Every Neighbor*

Judges should evaluate each submission using age-appropriate expectations for the student's grade category.

Judging Criteria	Points	Judges Should Consider
Content and Theme Interpretation	45	Does the artwork clearly interpret the theme Nourish Every Neighbor ? Does it communicate a meaningful message about food insecurity through service, compassion, dignity, or community action? Is the message clear and impactful?
Creativity and Originality	35	Does the student demonstrate imagination and originality in interpreting the theme? Does the artwork present a unique perspective or creative approach that captures the viewer's attention?
Artistic Ability	20	Does the artwork demonstrate age-appropriate artistic skill, thoughtful composition, effective use of color and design, and careful craftsmanship? Is the work complete and visually engaging?
